We chose to go through Seed Savers Exchange (www.seedsavers.org) because they are a non profit organization that offers a wide variety of fruits, vegetables, and flowers that are all organic heirloom seeds. Heirloom seeds have been passed down from generations and the seeds can be saved for replanting the following year!

If you are interested in our garden program, you can purchase seed packs for your child's classroom through Creative Minds! The children will then plant and tend to their gardens with the purchased seeds. Gardening is a learning tool for children and we are so excited to help them through the process.
